A Good Samaritan Cinquain

A cinquain is a five-line poem. Each line has one word more than the line before. The fifth line is one word. A cinquain can have rhyming words, but does not have to. Here's an explanation and example.

Explanation	Example
Line 1: One-word (This can be a title.)	Commandments
Line 2: Two words	Follow, obey
Line 3: Three words	as Jesus taught.
Line 4: Four-word statement	Love for God and
Line 5: One word	neighbor.
